

Speech Pathology Student Clinic:

Parkinson Disease



The WA Centre of Rural Health will offer the Lee Silverman Voice Treatment program – LSVT LOUD © for those with Parkinson Disease who would like to improve their voice and speech.

Participants will attend an assessment and then complete an intensive program of individual or group sessions. These sessions will be several times a week for four weeks followed by regular follow up.

The program will be run by Certified Practicing Speech Pathologists with support from final year students.

A GP clearance will be required prior to starting the treatment program in February 2021.

There is no cost for this program.
